



Paint Options for Application to NewWood Panel Face

NewWood has a low density polyethylene surface that makes it durable, virtually waterproof, and resistant to scuffing. Those very properties, however, limit the number of primers and finish paints that will adhere to the panel surface.

Paint manufacturers have identified for NewWood the following products that adhere to NewWood without any sanding or other surface preparation, other than having the surface clean and dry:

- Duramax Exterior Acrylic Latex by Valspar Paint
- Sherwin Williams Exterior Alkyd Wood Primer Y24W8020
- Glidden Gripper Primer – White
- Gaco Deck Primer
- APAC EnCapSeal Primer
- Sherwin Williams Latex Primer B42W1700 (a commercial grade that may be special ordered in their retail stores)
- Rust-Oleum Direct to Plastic Aerosol
- Krylon Fusion for Plastic Aerosol

With additional surface preparation, such as sanding, NewWood will accept many other paint products and stains, both latex and oil-based.

The four edges and cut edges from fabricating the board will readily accept any paint, stain or seam-sealing product.
